# Center for Clinical Investigation

## 2011 Research Grants Program

The Center for Clinical Investigation's (CCI) research grants program is designed to encourage clinical investigation by wound, ostomy and continence nurses, with the aim of strengthening the existing research base for our clinical practice. Additionally, the program is designed to support WOC specialty practice nurses to develop their role as researchers. Principal Investigators (PIs) must be members of the WOCN Society and RNs. Listed below are descriptions of this year's available grants:

- ◆ **Hollister, Inc.—WOCN Society CCI Grant**  
Two grants available up to \$10,000 each related to care of patients with an ostomy.
- ◆ **Molnlycke Health Care—WOCN Society CCI Grant**  
Up to \$10,000 for one grant related to critically colonized/infected chronic wounds.
- ◆ **Regenesis Biomedical—WOCN Society CCI Grant**  
Up to \$5,000 available for one grant for slow healing wounds that has not progressed satisfactorily in healing after 30 days of treatment.
- ◆ **Sage Products, Inc.—WOCN Society CCI Grant**  
Two grants available up to \$7,500 each. One grant available for incontinence associated dermatitis, and the second grant available for heel pressure.
- ◆ **WOCN Members' Research Grant**  
Up to \$7,500 available to fund one project related to any area of WOC nursing practice.
